



Alto ISD Cafeteria Policies & Procedures

Administrative Policy on Meal Charges

Students

All students on all campuses eat breakfast and lunch at no charge through Community Eligibility Provision. Milk/Juice are the only a la carte items sold in Cafeteria and must be paid for when receiving them or a parent may put money on the child's account.

Adults

All Alto ISD staff are allowed to charge and all charges must be paid by the 20th of every month. Payments for all meals must be accounted for at all times. Pre-paying on accounts is strongly encouraged. Outside visiting adults are charged the same price as staff and must pay when receiving food. Cafeteria workers are allowed to eat breakfast and lunch at no charge.

Special Dietary Needs (Food allergies)

If your child is in need of a special diet relating to a medical condition, please contact the school nurse or Food Service Director. Alto ISD has a special diet form that you can use to get your child's physician or medical authority to fill out and sign. Substitutions can only be made if it is required by a doctor's orders. Substitutions based on a child's personal likes and dislikes will not be made. You are welcome to use a form from your child's physician's office or feel free to print the special diet form linked to the first page.
